



Policy governing employment supports for people with disabilities

In collaboration with the Employment Team, we have conducted a scan of policy governing employment supports for people with disabilities in 14 jurisdictions in Canada – federal, provincial and territorial. This is the first of three reports supporting the work of each research team. Similar reports will be forthcoming in summer and fall for the Mobility Team and the Sport & Leisure Team.

The report focuses on legislation (rather than more informal forms of policy), and provides quick access to information about employment support legislation, programs, and contacts. In addition, it classifies policy according to the 3 objectives of disability policy:

- **Equity - prevention of discrimination;**
- **Access - ability to enter or use facilities or services; or**
- **Support - material resources.**
