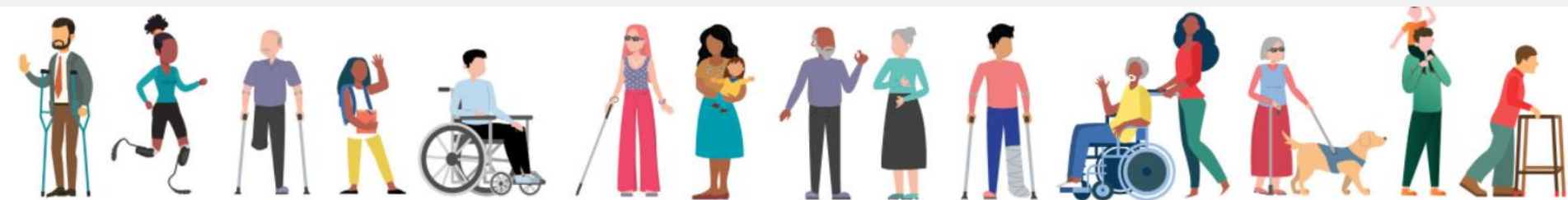




Statistics Canada Accessibility Hub

Disability scholars, advocates and policy makers will be interested in a new [data hub on Accessibility Statistics](#) at Statistics Canada, released in celebration of National Accessibility Week (May 30th – June 5th). The site is organized according to the five national accessibility priorities: built environment; programs & services; employment; information & communication; transportation. It provides information from the *Canada Survey on Disability*, including a new [data visualization tool](#). It also provides information on the four jurisdictions that currently have accessibility legislation – Canada, Ontario, Manitoba and Nova Scotia.
